Reading II

Heb 9:11-15

Brothers and sisters:

When Christ came as high priest of the good things that have come to be, passing through the greater and more perfect tabernacle not made by hands, that is, not belonging to this creation, he entered once for all into the sanctuary, not with the blood of goats and calves but with his own blood, thus obtaining eternal redemption. For if the blood of goats and bulls and the sprinkling of a heifer's ashes can sanctify those who are defiled so that their flesh is cleansed, how much more will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself unblemished to God, cleanse our consciences from dead works to worship the living God.

For this reason he is mediator of a new covenant: since a death has taken place for deliverance from transgressions under the first covenant, those who are called may receive the promised eternal inheritance.

Mk 14:12-16, 22-26

On the first day of the Feast of Unleavened Bread, when they sacrificed the Passover lamb, Jesus' disciples said to him, "Where do you want us to go and prepare for you to eat the Passover?" He sent two of his disciples and said to them, "Go into the city and a man will meet you, carrying a jar of water. Follow him. Wherever he enters, say to the master of the house, 'The Teacher says, "Where is my guest room where I may eat the Passover with my disciples?"' Then he will show you a large upper room furnished and ready. Make the preparations for us there." The disciples then went off, entered the city, and found it just as he had told them; and they prepared the Passover. While they were eating, he took bread, said the blessing, broke it, gave it to them, and said, "Take it; this is my body." Then he took a cup, gave thanks, and gave it to them, and they all drank from it. He said to them, "This is my blood of the covenant, which will be shed for many. Amen, I say to you, I shall not drink again the fruit of the vine until the day when I drink it new in the kingdom of God." Then, after singing a hymn, they went out to the Mount of Olives.

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

At the end of this Child Abuse Prevention Month, I want to rally us all together in prayer and support for all those in the cycle of abuse and trafficking. These are still an ugly but real part of our world. The fight against child abuse and the battle for the dignity of the human person is far from over because original sin is still very much alive, and our enemy is a clever one and on the prowl. Human weakness will always be with us in this valley of tears; nevertheless, some sin and crime can be tolerated even a little. Please stand with me with your prayers.

Further the time has now come after three years to renew each of our Safe Environment Training. Remember with me that this training is the United States Catholic Church's response to the reality of child abuse. In it you will learn what to look for if a child is being abused and who to contact if you know or suspect that abuse is happening. Adults who prey on children are manipulative and clever. They turn all their powers on the child and try to hide themselves.

Thus, it is my hope that every adult here at Christ the Redeemer will join me in taking child abuse prevention seriously. We are now given a moment, to say with our actions that no instance of abuse will be tolerated. Each of us who might be a safe place for a child to share their hurt must be ready and equipped to act. Certainly, many of us are legally mandated reporters, but more so this is not merely about fulfilling some law, but about protecting those innocent little ones around us whose angels are always before the face of God.

Dear brothers and sisters, please stand with me in prayer and in preparation for this fight. Please be prepared to renew your Safe Environment Training. More information will be coming shortly.
