- The Way of the Cross will be offered on Fridays at 5:30 PM.
- An additional mass will be offered on Fridays following the Way of the Cross around 6:00 PM.
- We will again be participating in the Catholic Relief Service's Rice Bowl program as a way for almsgiving during the season of Lent. They should be returned by April 2. These funds go to feed the poor the world over.
- Also will have our easter egg project to collect items for our local food bank.
- Mercy Night is an experience of Eucharistic Adoration, Praise and Worship, guided meditation, and confession. It begins at 6:00 PM on Wednesday during Lent.
